Legal context of the German LkSG

The German Supply Chain Due Diligence Act (LkSG) applies to companies that meet the statutory size thresholds. According to BAFA information, since 2024 companies with at least 1,000 employees in Germany are covered.

Scope

Based on its current company size, MAG does not fall directly within the statutory scope of the LkSG.

Cooperation

Suppliers that are not directly obliged may still receive LkSG-related enquiries from their customers.

No duty transfer

According to BAFA, LkSG duties may not be transferred to suppliers; obliged companies remain responsible.

What this means in practice

- MAG supports customers with central standard evidence and objective case-by-case reviews.
- Enquiries should be risk-based, specific and understandable for the relevant product group or business relationship.
- Commitments must match the available evidence, MAG's actual sphere of influence and the respective business relationship.
- Statutory duties under the LkSG remain with the companies that themselves fall within the statutory scope.

Source note

This summary is based on publicly available BAFA information on the LkSG and cooperation in the supply chain, as well as information from the German Federal Environment Ministry on scope and due diligence obligations.

Keeping statements reliable

We want to support customers while making only statements that MAG can actually represent and document.

- No blanket guarantee of full compliance with all requirements by all upstream suppliers or global supply chain tiers.
- No automatic signing of external customer-specific questionnaires, individual declarations or framework agreements.
- No unlimited audit, liability, control or contractual commitments outside specific, separately agreed business relationships.
- No statements that go beyond MAG's actual sphere of influence, available evidence or reliable information.

Suggested wording for customer questionnaires
